CIRCULAR

**Sub: Revision of rates for purchase of animals from progressive breeders.**

As recommended by the Committee constituted for revision of rates for purchase of livestock from progressive breeders, vide Joint Director Farms, SHD Jammu's No. JDFJ/ Tech/ 2021-22/528 dated 12.08.2021; the following rates and modalities shall be followed by the Purchase committees for purchase of Crossbred Rams/ Ewes/ Bucks/ Does with immediate effect:

\* **The Super Stud value for categories 1 to 4 in case of Ovines shall be awarded specifically for purchase of livestock for Government Farms when the purchase committee is satisfied that the animal to be purchased is an extraordinary animal with super stud qualities in respect of body weight, fleece quality, fleece yield, etc., as detailed below:**


1. Male in age group of milk tooth to one and half years should weigh above 40 Kg. and have fiber diameter up to 20 micron.
2. Female in age group of milk tooth to one and half years should weigh above 35 Kg. and has fiber diameter up to 20 micron.

**Note:**

1. The rates of various categories of livestock have been revised in view of the present requirements of the Department and in order to encourage the breeders for producing better quality animals.
2. The field officers shall ensure Fleece analysis report of wool samples of earmarked sheep and produce the same at time of purchase of animals by the purchase committee.
3. SDO/ VAS of the concerned jurisdiction shall be co-opted as member of the purchase committee already framed by the Government. Similarly the concerned Farm officer shall be necessarily co-opted as member of purchase committee while purchasing elite ewes for the Sheep Breeding Farm.
4. The purchased animals shall be branded immediately after completion of modalities for purchase under rule.
5. Screening of purchased animals for diseases of zoonotic importance viz. brucellosis, etc. shall be ensured by concerned field/ farm officer.
6. Rate of recoveries in case of missing/ negligent deaths of farm animals as circulated vide this office No.: DSHJ/ Tech/ 2012-13/ 2285-2307 dated: 14.06.2012 also stands modified to rates as mentioned above for different category of livestock. Rest of the modalities as mentioned in the circular will remain same.

The guidelines will remain in force till revised by this Directorate.
