Subject: Issuance of updated seniority list of Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of Sheep Husbandry Department.

Whereas, vide Government Order No: 142-ASH of 2010 dated 25.10.2010, a final seniority list of Veterinary Assistant Surgeons of Sheep Husbandry Department, as it stood on 1.9.2010 was notified; and

Whereas, as a consequence of appointment of Veterinary Assistant Surgeons/retirement of some officers/resignation/termination of lien of some officers, due to their appointment elsewhere, after the notification of seniority list, it has become necessary to issue an updated seniority list of the members of the service as it stood on 01.01.2013; and

Whereas, during the process of examination of the matter, it has been found as under:-

- 1/ the services of one Dr. Gurdeep Singh Sodhi figuring at Seniority No. 72 were terminated w.e.f. 23.01.1999 due to un-authorized absence vide Govt. Order No: 4-ASH of 2013 dated 3.1.2013
- 2/ the seniority position of Dr. Shahnawaz Naqashbandi, whose period of un-authorized absence was treated as dies-non was not refixed as per the import of dies-non, which includes loss of seniority, in the seniority list issued in the year 2010.
- 3/ seniority of Dr. Amitha Baddamwar, Dr. Mubashir Ali, Dr. Farooq Ahmad Lone, Dr. Zahoor-ul-Haq and Dr. Zakir Hussain was not fixed in accordance with merit obtained by them in J&K Public Services Commission and needed necessary corrections.
- 4/ the date of birth of some of the officers was not reflected appropriately and in some cases correction in the names of officers etc. were recommended by the concerned Directors.

Whereas, apart from above issues, seniority position of Dr. Moin-ul-Haq was refixed vide Government Order No: 142-ASH of 2010 dated 25.10.2010 due to treatment of his un-authorized absence w.e.f. 9.7.1997 to 13.7.1998 as dies-non against which the officer filed a writ petition SWP No. 354/2011; and
